A Thought From Mark...

"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." – 1 Corinthians 15:58

Wow! What a difference one verse of Scripture has the potential to make, if lived out! Imagine if all of us internalized these inspired words from Paul, learned what they meant, and proceeded to live what we learned from them. It would make for stronger people and stronger churches.

We begin with the first word of this verse this week – "Therefore..." Always an important word in the Bible – the old saw is that when you see the word "therefore," you need to look and see what it is there for. This "therefore" comes after one of the great chapters of the New Testament – the resurrection chapter of the Bible – 1 Corinthians chapter 15. Paul presents all the implications of the resurrection of Jesus – what it means if it didn't happen – and what it means since it did. He writes of the great hope we have in Christ of a resurrection of our own to come one day. Death will not get the last word over those who belong to Jesus – life will – eternal life.

Based on the great hope and meaning of the resurrection first of Jesus and second of all who follow Him, then, the words of verse 58 arise. Hence, the "therefore."

"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain."

All the behaviors and attitudes called for in this powerful verse of Scripture originate in the gospel truth of the resurrection. The resurrection, you see, calls for steadfastness, hard work in the Lord, and understanding that such work in not meaningless.

Next week we will look at the next part of this wonderful verse from the Word of God.
