

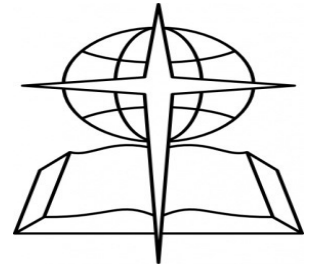

A Thought From Mark...

September 2nd my Wednesday night class will pick back up following the end of Summer Series. I hope we have all enjoyed and been blessed by the speakers and their teaching on family-related themes during these summer months. My Wednesday class meets in the MP Room and we will begin with a video series from brother Dale Manor. Dr. Manor is a teacher at Harding University and a respected authority in Biblical studies and Biblical archaeology. Each summer he leads an archaeological dig in Israel.

I have known of and read after Dr. Manor for many years, but it was just this past year that I got to meet and hear him face to face here in Vienna when he spoke at the Warren Apologetics Forum down at Grand Pointe Conference Center. I found him to be very interesting and engaging as a teacher.
