When I returned back home from Gambella, Ethiopia, I met with other preachers of the Lord's Church at the Meru School of Theology on 9th December, 2015. I asked some of them whether they would like me to speak to their congregations for which they agreed. I asked them what they would like me to teach and they proposed several areas of concern.

The preachers discussed several denominational elements that had crept into the Lord's Church and the difficulties they faced teaching against them. Some of these elements:

- Use of instruments in worship, especially by youth;
- Dancing when singing for the Lord;
- Testimonies during service;
- Repetitions (Praise God!! Amen!!, Hallelujah!! Amen!!);
- 'Baptizing' little babies

I agreed to join them in teaching the doctrine of the Church of Christ on a volunteer basis. I also invited them for Bible studies at Makutano, Meru, where I plan to plant a congregation as soon as possible.

- Help me pray that the young congregations in Meru will hold firmly to the New Testament Church doctrine.
- Help me pray that the Bible studies and door knocking at Makutano will result to more souls obeying the gospel.
