A Thought From Mark...

It has been a little over a week now that we all lost a dear friend and a brother in Christ, Joe Newberry. I have seen few people inspire more prayer and expressions of love and concern than Joe did in his battle with liver disease. You as his brothers and sisters rose to the occasion with untold numbers of prayers and supplications on he and his family's behalf, and you continue to help and support them in many ways.

Joe was a special person in many ways. He had a way of expressing love and friendship to everybody he came in contact with, young or old. Joe was my friend, one of my very best friends. That was not always the case. In the early years of knowing each other we clashed on more than one occasion. But our friendship grew over time as we raised families together, ate together, played together, and prayed together. Joe was not just a close friend, but he was a loyal friend – and we all know there is a difference. There is a friend who sticks closer than a brother (Proverbs 18:24).

I have been in ministry here for over 20 years, but I have little to no experience with a situation like this, where a peer and a close friend dies what we all see as an untimely death. Please pray for me as I try to serve you and Joe's family during this hard time.

I hope you all will make a special effort to attend the memorial and celebration of life service planned for our friend and brother next Saturday, April 9th, here at the church building.

Joe lost a physical battle but won a far greater spiritual war on a weekend Christians call Easter. I guess for a Christian, who believes Jesus rose again on the 3rd day, and believes His promise that one day He will call everyone forth from their grave as well, it was a poignant time to pass from this realm to the next. Joe passed on a Saturday. Jesus spent Saturday in a sealed tomb. But on Sunday – oh on Sunday!! – on that "great getting' up mornin" – Jesus came forth and changed the world forever! And because of that, one day, we all shall rise.

So, comfort one another with these words. And go love on somebody like Joe showed us.

(Genesis 1:28)

As the story of mankind unfolds, we find more specific purposes God had in mind. Paul writes, "for we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them." (Ephesians 2:10)

The wise teacher sums it up this way, "The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man." (Ecclesiastes 12:13)

If we do these things for which God created us, then He will be glorified (Matthew 5:16), which is the ultimate purpose for all creation (Psalm 19:1).
