## Longsuffering

Being patient is not one of the things I do very well. The more I have to practice patience, the more I understand why the word is sometimes translated longSUFFERING! We live in a society that measures success by how quickly we attain our goals. But there is no room for impatience when our objective is to teach and baptize the lost.

When we are trying to reach someone with the gospel, our goal cannot be to see how quickly we can get them to agree to study, or how quickly we can get them into the baptistery. Our purpose is to help them understand the Word of God, and make their own decision based on their understanding. We must emphasize the urgency, but yet allow them time to process the information.

We get impatient with a person who cannot accept a concept they have just encountered for the first time, yet it may be a concept we struggled with for years. We do the same thing as parents; we impart some tidbit of wisdom to our children that we learned by ignoring our parents' warnings, then we can't understand why they don't just accept what we say.

Patience is listed as a fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22). Jesus said Christians will produce new Christians with patience (Luke 8:15). Let us pray for God to fill us with His Spirit and give us the patience we need. The patience that comes from God will allow us to spend an entire evening studying just one passage, and yet consider the night a success because we were able to help someone understand a part of God's Word.
