**A Thought From Mark...**

I am planning on beginning a new study in my Wednesday night class this week entitled "**Churches of Christ: Where Did We Come From?**" This is sort of an overview of the Restoration Movement, and we are going to try and approach it from a narrative viewpoint, that is, by telling the stories of some of the major movers and shakers of the Movement. If you do not know what the Restoration Movement is or was, that is perfectly fine, and that is the purpose of the class. You are all invited.

**Some important ideas from Restoration Movement leaders:**

- "Where the Scriptures speak, we speak; where the Scriptures are silent, we are silent."
- "The church of Jesus Christ on earth is essentially, intentionally, and constitutionally one."
- "We are Christians only, but not the only Christians."
- "In essentials, unity; in opinions, liberty; in all things love."
- "No creed but Christ, no book but the Bible, no law but love, no name but the divine."
- "Do Bible things in Bible ways."
- "Call Bible things by Bible names."

**Did you know?**

One of the movement's preachers became a President of the United States?

That the movement divided in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century over the use of instrumental music in worship and other issues?

That there was a strong pacifist strain to the movement?

That there was a significant anti-slavery sentiment in the movement?

That it became the largest indigenous religious movement in American history?

That it also had great influence in the British Isles?

**Continue Steadfastly in Prayer**

As part of the 3-6-5 Pray Every Day initiative, our congregation currently has 36 members who have pledged to pray for one of their friends or neighbors every day over a twelve month period. It is exciting to look forward to the changes we will see in the lives of those being prayed for, as well as those doing the praying!

Each situation is unique. Some are praying for a lost soul to come to Christ. Others are praying for someone who has fallen away to come back. Some are praying for various health situations or family problems. Regardless of the purpose of our prayers, God has promised that if we are trying to do His will, He will put His power to work for us (Matthew 7:7).

Think about the implications of that promise! God promises that He hears and considers each of our prayers! He has promised to grant our requests that are within His will! If there is someone we care deeply about that God can help in some way, how can we not be pleading with Him every day to help them?!

Prayer is the one thing that we can do confidently and consistently in each situation. The object of our prayers may not be open to speak with us about the gospel, but we can pray for a change of heart. We may not know the right thing to say, but we can pray that God will give us the right words, and that he will use the words we choose for good. We may not be a doctor or nurse, but we can ask the Great Physician to heal.

You don't need a church program to pray every day for someone you care about. Ask God to give you an attitude and a spirit of prayer, and you will find yourself asking Him to intercede in the lives of everyone you know!

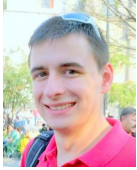
