**The Lord's Supper**

In Acts 2:42 we read that the Christians devoted themselves to the breaking of bread. Since this was a meal to which they were devoted, and since it is different from the meals they ate together in their homes (verse 46), I believe this breaking of bread refers to the Lord's Supper.

Did the weekly observance of communion help to bring about the tremendous growth of the Lord's church in the first century? Can our participation in the Lord's Supper affect our ability to reach the lost with the gospel? I would answer yes to these questions for two reasons, both of which are found in 1 Corinthians chapter 11:

1) The purpose of the Lord's Supper is to remind us of the sacrifice Jesus made for us (verses 23-25). To remember how and why our sins have been forgiven is an important part of living the Christian life. All we need to know in order to win a soul for Christ is that we are a Christian, and how we became one. Look at how many times Paul tells the story of his conversion. If we can tell a lost soul what Jesus has done for us, and how he has made a difference in our life, then we can share the gospel as God intended. The Lord's Supper reminds us of these things, therefore our weekly participation can make us more effective soul winners.

2) Another purpose of the Lord's Supper is to "proclaim the Lord's death until He comes" (verse 26). True, we proclaim it to each other, but don't we also proclaim it to the non-Christian visitors to our worship? It is a time during our service that we speak specifically about the death of our Lord and what it means. Our visitors can learn much about the gospel by simply observing our communion. Let us not forget the importance of inviting to worship those we are trying to reach.

The Lord's Supper should never become a routine that we participate in without thinking. Let us reflect from time to time that our observance of communion will help us be better prepared in our efforts to reach the lost.

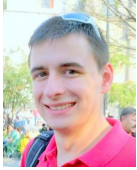
