From time to time churches put together directories in order to have a handy resource of addresses and phone numbers, etc. to keep us connected. Sometimes we even have picture directories to aid in identification. Many secular organizations do the same thing for similar purposes.

While I was Praying...

In Acts 2:42 we read that the Christians devoted themselves to prayer. Reading through the entire book of Acts confirms this fact, as there are at least twenty references to Christians praying, both together and as individuals. As a result, we see many "while I was praying" stories in the description of the early church.

A perfect example is the story of Peter and Cornelius in chapters 10 and 11. Cornelius, a non-Christian, is described as "devout and Godfearing," and he "prayed to God regularly." Cornelius tells that **while he was praying** an angel appeared telling him to send for Peter. When Peter recounts the story to the church in Jerusalem, he tells that the men sent by Cornelius arrived at the end of the vision he experienced **while he was praying**.

How many "while I was praying" stories do you have? I seem to have plenty of "while I was driving" and "while I was eating" stories, but when I read the book of Acts I am motivated to strengthen my prayer life. We don't know how many people in our sphere of influence might be praying right now for God to send someone to them with the message of salvation. Wouldn't it be great if we could stand with a new Christian and tell that we learned about each other "while we were praying?!"

Obviously part of the reason the church in Jerusalem grew so quickly was their reliance on prayer. The Scriptures are filled with promises that God will answer the prayers of His people. Let's get on our knees and pray for the people we have been trying to reach with the gospel. Let's pray for the Lord's church to become more spiritual and evangelistic. Let's show God that we trust Him to keep His promises.

After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.


