# A Thought From Mark...

The church is full of servants. Being a servant is basic to being a follower of Christ, and so clearly the church is to be made up of such servants. In the New Testament, there were at times special servants for special tasks appointed at special times. These were (and are) called "deacons" (Greek: diakonos, meaning "servant").

We first read of these special servants for special tasks in Acts chapter 6, where 7 were appointed to the task of taking special care of the Greek widows in the Jerusalem church. A problem arose in the church – a complaint – that these widows were not being taken care of properly – Acts 6:1. The apostles, who led the church at the time, called on all the disciples to choose from among themselves men to tend to this task – Acts 6:2-3.

Seven were chosen by the church and appointed to their task by the apostles. These 7 were:

<u>Stephen</u> – he was full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, full also of grace and power, and did great signs and wonders among the people. Acts 6:5, 8. He would become the first Christian martyr – Acts 7.

<u>Philip</u> – in addition to his service to the Jerusalem church he would become a missionary to Samaria and would evangelize an Ethiopian nobleman – Acts 6:5; 8:5, 26-40.

<u>Prochorus</u> – he was a man of good reputation and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom – Acts 6:3, 5.

<u>Nicanor</u> - he was a man of good reputation and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom - Acts 6:3, 5.

<u>Timon</u> - he was a man of good reputation and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom - Acts 6:3, 5.

<u>Parmenas</u> - he was a man of good reputation and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom - Acts 6:3, 5.

Nicolaus - he also was a man of good reputation and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, and was a proselyte of Antioch - Acts 6:3, 5.

Seven deeply spiritual men appointed to important physical tasks in the church of our Lord. They were called upon in response to a need, and they responded with Christlike service. Good examples for all current and prospective deacons in the church of Christ to consider and emulate!

# You're Invited to the Wedding

Weddings are big deals. There's lots of planning and decorating. There are fancy invitations that go out and tons of anticipation for the "big event." People dress up and come to the church building, and there's even a preacher – how exciting! But, the wedding is most meaningful to the bride and groom. A wedding is a ceremony where a man and a woman pledge their love and commitment before God and witnesses as they enter into the marriage covenant. It represents the beginning of a new life together as husband and wife. A unique bond is formed and a new relationship is inaugurated.

The marriage covenant is used in the Bible to illustrate the bond between Jesus Christ and his followers. The church is the bride of Christ (Revelation 21:2,9; 22:17; 2 Corinthians 11:2; Ephesians 5:25-27). Our commitment to Christ in the waters of baptism functions as the believers' wedding ceremony (see Galatians 3:27; Acts 22:16; 2:38).

In **Revelation 19:6-9** John envisions a joyous celebration. The shout of "Hallelujah!" goes forth because the Lord has begun to reign and he has invited believers to join in the wedding feast. "Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready; it was granted to her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure" (vs.7,8).

Because of who Jesus is and what he's done, we can be part of a unique bond and a new relationship. As the church, we are the bride of Christ and are thus invited to be part of the celebration (see also Jesus' parable of the wedding feast in Matthew 22:1-14). Don't throw out your invitation to the marriage supper. Remember, redemption and heaven is assured for those in the church.

"Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb" (vs.9).
