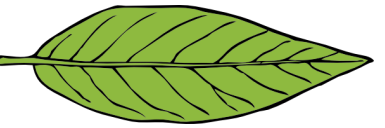

Exciting days are ahead for us at the 36th Street church. On Sunday evening, March 24, we will have our monthly children's worship. 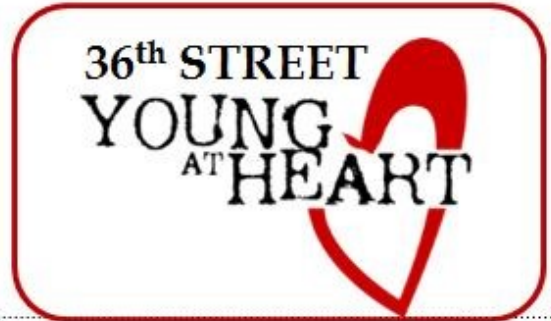
