

Only 30 months (counting this month which is half over) until we can celebrate the 100th year of the church meeting on this property! In May 2024, we will have spent 52 years as the 36th Street Church of Christ and 48 years as the 34th Street Church of Christ and before that the Pleasant Street Church of Christ on the other corner as the "new building" dates to May 28, 1972.

Some among us remember the old building (plus additions) and many of the 8 full-time pulpit and 4 associate ministers (one who became a pulpit minister) who have served here since 1958. Of the 19 elders who have served since 1946, 9 are still members here, and 4 of those currently shepherd us. At the time of the construc-

tion of the new building, one of those 9 who is still a member here, was an elder serving then with 4 others, one of whom was the father of one of the current 4.

October was a crazy month with a spike in the virus that kept many of us (myself included) away. It also found me moving my last family member here to live and wrapping up the evangelism class series before the time change. During that time, however, many materials from the past were located, and I've been able to familiarize myself (new as I am) to this church's history worth celebrating!

With the busyness of the holidays and events scheduled through the end of the year, a full thrust of work by those wishing to serve on the Centennial Committee won't occur until the calendar flips to 2022, but an initial brainstorming meeting will be held on Thursday, December 9, at 7 p.m. in the multipurpose room, so we may be ready when the new year begins. All interested are invited to attend.

Help us celebrate the past century while planning for 36th Street's next 100 years.

George & Sue Teel (former members) are having some health problems; George was recently in the hospital but is home now. Cards would be appreciated, address on board in foyer.


