Taking Jesus at His Word

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE: Luke 20:1-8

Jesus continues to teach in the temple courts and to preach the gospel. Jesus is confronted by the chief priest, scribes and elder—the religious leaders of the Jewish people.

The first question of these leaders was "Who gave you the authority to do **these things?**" They are likely referring to His driving the merchants from the temple courts as well as his teaching there. The question "**Who is the one who gave you this authority?**" is a loaded question which is meant to force Jesus into dilemma. If claims God gave him his authority, they would try to turn people against Him for claiming that He was speaking for God. On the other hand, if claims to be acting on his own authority, they would dismiss him as just another pretender, after all as Sanhedrin had authority over the temple. These leaders have clearly rejected Jesus and His message of the kingdom.

Jesus understands their ploy and quickly He turns tables on them. He asks them a question placing them in same dilemma planned for Him.

Jesus recognizes that he is very much like John, in that the people accept him while the leadership rejects him. They cannot say that John had brought a message from heaven because Jesus would simply respond, "Why did you not believe him?" He might ask, "Why did you not go down to the Jordan River to be baptized?" On the other hand, they cannot say, "John's baptism was from men because the people are convinced that John was a prophet, and might stone them. Rather than give their actual opinion (John's baptism from men), they plead ignorance.

They were supposed to be teachers and the experts in the Law. If anyone was able to recognize a false teacher, it should be they.

Jesus responds, "Then I won't tell you by what authority I do these things." If they cannot make this decision about John and his claims, how can they possibly understand the authority Jesus is exercising.

Today...I will take Jesus at His word and obey him.
