'The LORD is My Portion,' Says My Soul ... by Doug Kashorek

On a shelf in my office is a small, zippered KJV Bible that was given to me on 12/25/81 by my parents. While most ten-year-olds returned to school after New Year's wearing clothes they'd soon outgrow or bragging about candy they'd already eaten, I was turning pages by flashlight under the covers late into the night. I can't describe how reading the stories in the Bible for the first time captivated my young heart and mind ... and laid a foundation of love for God's Word that has carried me into adulthood.

Let them have the outfits, the toys, and the stockings full of sweets—things that are temporary and destined to perish with this world. My portion was the LORD and of eternal value! Of course, that spark had to survive my teenage years, when at one point it manifested in me wanting to become a Catholic priest.

It wouldn't be until college that my Uncle John (he'll help perform my second wedding this Saturday) fanned it into flame and gave it direction. I hungrily read the entire New Testament one Christmas break, and on Valentine's Day, eleven years and two months after that first Bible, he baptized my then fiancé and me into Christ—who was the portion I sought.

God was the portion for the Levites and Aaron's descendants when the Promised Land was divided (Numbers 18:20-23), but in a sense, among all the nations of the world, God's chosen people of the Old Testament were "*a kingdom of priests and a holy nation*" Exodus 19:6. When they reeled in their captivity, having compromised with the world, they acknowledged that the LORD should have been their portion (Lamentations 3:24).

And so, God's chosen people of the New Testament are to be "*a royal priesthood, a holy nation*" (1 Peter 2:9), that out of all the world, we are "*a chosen race*" to have Christ as our portion. So, let the world have the temporary things of this life, and let us seek the eternal things that will last. Does your soul say that Jesus is your portion?
