What's That Book You've Found?

The theme for both our singing services this morning and evening is "Holy Bible, Book Divine." This will give an opportunity for our song leaders to focus on the many songs that speak of God's Word as inspired truth, our help, and our guide. The other elements of worship will all be there, including an AM devotional thought from me and PM one from John Eckhart.

It's "*living and active*" and useful "*for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,*" thoroughly equipping the man (and woman) of God for every good work. So ... how could they lose it?

Perhaps the priests knew where it was all along but kept it hidden during Manasseh and Amon's combined, idolatrous reigns of almost six decades to preserve it. Then, they waited another ten years for Josiah to get into adulthood (2 Chronicles 34) before they could see that the reforms he made showed a change in heart from his predecessors. Whatever the reason, when they read it to the young king, he tore his clothes and asked that they inquire of the LORD for him as he was convinced that all their problems were because they had "*not kept the word of the LORD, to do according to all that is written in this book.*"

Wouldn't it be great if we understood that the problems in the world, our churches, even our families were because we weren't wholeheartedly following "*all that is written in this book*"? And yet, instead of just one copy, we live in a time when we are surrounded by more digital and paper copies in more translations than any other time in history.

So, where is God's Word hidden? Right in plain sight. Time to blow the dust off and realize just how precious is the book that we have found.
