Three weekends from now, we will host Dean Miller's Widowhood Workshop—on October 7-9. We have not hosted an event with invitations to attend that are so far-reaching in a very long time! So, this serves as a warm-up for an even bigger Centennial celebration nineteen months from now as we all work together to make this event a success and let 36th Street's light shine.

As the percentage of couples dying at the same time is very low, statistically one in a marriage will be widowed. Widowhood Workshop, then, will encourage, educate, and equip those planning to wed, already married, or those who already know spousal loss. So our cooks can prepare for numbers, everyone who registers by October 2 will receive a free mug when he or she attends the event the following weekend. To register, please call the church office or fill-out a form in the foyer.

On the registration sheet, there are lines to check for attending the introductory session on Friday evening, the three sessions on Saturday morning into early afternoon, and the two Sunday morning sessions at our regular class and worship times. We're maximizing efforts to get the word out through mailings, phone calls, our electronic sign, and other advertising means.
