You Don't Fight Fair!

I saw this with my own kids. Being the oldest, my son would often use his size and strength to bully his sisters, despite my constant admonitions not to. My older daughter would retaliate, though, with a sharp and witty tongue that stabbed him right through the heart and twisted.

This illustrates the different ways in which males and females fight. Men are more overt and plow ahead with strength and force, often misusing the gifts that God has given them to function as protectors. Women, however, are more covert and find subtle, emotional ways to get what they want, often misusing the gifts that God has given them to be nurturers.

Yet, boys are told not to hit girls, while girls, whose wiles or methods are just as hurtful, often go unrestrained. This gives them an unfair advantage, I've always thought.

Jael fought this way. Using the friendship that her husband had with Sisera, the commander of the Canaanite army, she lured him into their tent with the false promises of rest and safety while he fled Barak, the commander of Israel's army. She went above and beyond, deceiving him with milk when he asked for water, a move that certainly appeared nurturing. Then, she waited until her subtle wiles had let Sisera fall asleep before she pounded a tent stake through his temple!

The world fights by misusing the masculine way and forcing its will on all who don't agree with it, especially Christians. Bullying tactics are used to make us fearful and conform. 2 Corinthians tells us, however, that we don't wage war like the world does. Instead, using God's gifts of faith, hope, and love (1 Corinthians 13) and the fruits of the Spirit (Galatians 5) in the way that He intended for us to do so, we have "divine power to destroy strongholds."

Yet, still worldly in nature, many Christians want to fight the culture "fairly" by using the world's weapons against it. Will we win souls or drive them away? Rather, we should use the advantages God has given us to spread His gospel.
