If cooking a turkey for the **Thanksgiving Extravaganza**, you should have already picked up your bird from the building (please don't take the roasting pans that are there). Della will be at the church this Friday from 6-7 pm, and all food should be in the kitchen starting at 9 am on Saturday, 11/19. Extra crockpots are needed. We'll enjoy a meal together at noon and then deliver meals (50 at last count) in the afternoon.

Mark is collecting **funds** for the kids at **Rolling Hills** (formerly Powell Apartments) through 11/27, so the staff there can buy gifts for many who would not get any presents otherwise. 36th Street has come through in big ways for this in past years that have been described by staff as "remarkable."

Before really cold weather sets in, the **Pantry & Closet** is collecting coats, hats, gloves, socks, boots, and blankets to give away throughout the winter.

There's a white box in the foyer through 12/11 to collect **items** for the **Crisis Intervention Center** (all beds are full right now), which includes paper & cleaning products, laundry & dish detergents, 13 gallon trash bags & other kitchen items. A full list is near the box. No diapers are needed at this time.

Gifts are needed for a growing number of kids (ages inside bulletin) by 12/10. On Friday, 12/16, at 6 pm, there will be a **wrapping party** in the MPR.

Finally, we'll wrap up 2022 with our annual **year-end contribution** through Sundays in December, which will benefit **Churches of Christ Disaster Relief** and perhaps other ministries to be named.
