### Who are You Voting For?

Relax! I'm not getting political just days before an election ... at least as far as our secondary citizenship is concerned. After all, our citizenship is first in heaven (Philippians 3:20), right? Although we know that heaven is a benevolent monarchy with Jesus being the King of Kings, is His kingdom on earth, the church, really socialism as some of Christianity's detractors have charged? Was Jesus, perhaps, a communist?

One source defines socialism in this way: *a political and economic theory of social organization which advocates that the means of production, distribution, and exchange should be owned or regulated by the community as a whole.* At first glance this sounds a lot like the early church, where *"no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common"* Acts 4:32. But, as we look deeper, this is just testimony to a generous spirit.

In the next chapter, a couple, wanting to appear generous before their brothers and sisters, lied about the amount of money they had gotten for a piece of property and said they were donating it all to the church. Peter said to them, *"While it remained unsold, did it not remain your own? And after it was sold, was it not at your disposal?"* We learn by this that early Christians were NOT required to sell their property and possessions for use of the whole. Then, it was always in the couple's control to distribute, not the church's or the leaders' (government's) to give to the needy. So, not socialism, but just good people who want to help others!

So ... who are you voting for? Because, you see, our place in Christ's kingdom on earth is determined by our vote—not just on the second Tuesday of November—but every day. Like Ananias and Sapphira, we cast our ballots every moment for the one we'd like to hold the office of our hearts. Will we by deception vote for ourselves while lying to everyone that we are generous Christians? Or will we choose to sacrificially serve our Savior in every thought, word, and deed?
