Behind the Scenes for ... The Life of David

Today starts a 21-class look at *The Life of David*. An influential figure and powerful servant for sure, studying the highlights of the one God describes in Acts 13:22 as “a man after my heart, who will do all my will” will connect God’s plan for salvation, the foundation of which was laid in our study of Genesis through last summer, with Jesus, David’s descendant. Okay, so David is a good choice to study. But why now?

For that answer, we need to pull back the curtain and glimpse what is behind the scenes. When I came to 36th Street in July 2021, we had two ministers, two interns, and a Bible college nearby. By this time a year ago, OVU was gone ... and it was just me with occasional help from our elders and a few others. Our study of Genesis that began when Mike was with us, moved to just Sunday classes as our *Love Letters* summer series in 2022 gave us an overview of how Jesus and the gospel were found in Paul’s epistles. As we moved into fall, we examined in great detail Romans, 1 Corinthians, and 2 Corinthians.

But now we’ve begun our 100th year, and the Centennial Committee that I’ve been leading is busy planning events for throughout this next year but especially for our month-long celebration in May 2024 ... all while Widows Walk strives to meet the needs of the grieving among us and I present on average three of the four lessons per week each quarter. Our gospel overview summer series 2023, also frees up some of my time to work on our centennial history book.

As my role is to preach “*the whole counsel of God*” (Acts 20:27), no planning is haphazard. Thirteen guest preachers presenting the hope that God has given us from Genesis through Revelation each Wednesday this summer will connect God’s plan of salvation while an examination of David’s life will deepen our understanding of our Savior, who, as God in the flesh, is the fulfillment of “*a man after God’s heart.*”
