For Freedom, Christ Has Set Us Free

Through most of our country's history, we have prized freedom—above even our own lives. We afforded great honors upon the men and women who have died to preserve that freedom for us and given respect to those who have served in our military ... because they defended it.

I've felt the same way towards faithful Christians who have died in the Lord and labored in the cause of the Kingdom. Why? Because they believed so strongly in the gospel message that they lived it out in their lives and taught others to do so. Why? Because of the freedom that Jesus brought them. How? Through the blood that He has shed for us.

Galatians 5:1 tells us that it is *"for freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery."* That's not at all what the world says. They insist the opposite—that those who have obeyed the gospel are the ones enslaved and that one is not truly free until he is doing what he wants. And then they would say that those who define their behavior as sin are restricting their 'freedom' because we insist on God's biblical standard.

Jesus tells us the opposite of culture would have us believe: *"... everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin. The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever. So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed"* John 8:34-36.

So, how has the Son set us free? In the same way the American soldier has—by laying down his life that we *might* be free. As 2 Corinthians 5:21 explains it, *"For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."* To do that a sinless Jesus willingly bore our sins on a cruel cross, dying for us so we *might* live.

Since Jesus has made us free, how should we live in our new freedom—for Him or shackled in a yoke of slavery?
