Is Your Ministry Effective?

As this month ends, I will have completed 25 years of ministry! Without having raised the full amount yet that I needed for my young family, I took a leap of faith by quitting my tenured English teaching position and began a 23-year work with the Plattsburgh Church of Christ on August 1, 1998. I have ministered here at 36th Street for two years now.

It's been a quarter of a century of asking God to guide me in the direction I should go. Neither did Manoah rely on his own understanding. When told by the angel that he and his wife would have a special child from God, he prayed that God would *"teach us what we are to do with the child who will be born"* Judges 13:8. And that's what each of us should do to make our personal ministries effective.

Two Mondays ago, our elders and I heard Jeff & Dale Jenkins speak on a dozen keys to effective ministry at the New Concord Church of Christ in Ohio. Though geared for church leaders, these points are easily adapted to personal ministries:

1. know your Northern Star (fix your eyes upon Jesus)
2. never forget why you're doing what you're doing
3. influence is cash (you've got to have a relationship with people)
4. accept the same grace you preach
5. you've got to keep growing
6. we need three men in our lives: a Paul (older mentor), a Barnabas (an encourager), and a Timothy (into whom we can pour our lives)
7. the longer you stay hurt or offended, the less effective you will be
8. always believe you have the better end of the deal
9. learn to not get your way and be joyful about it
10. do some things just because you're a Christian
11. preach the Word and love people
12. keep Christ first in your life

If you seek to do His will, He will keep you effective in your ministry.

Tuesdays—lift up all teachers of His Word

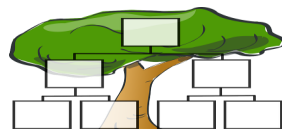
Wednesdays—wisdom & work of our leaders
