## What's the Scariest Song?

Isn't it whatever music is playing in the horror movie? Young general music students find this fun song a bit frightening: "*Witches and goblins and jack-o-lanterns bright, Creep through the town on this cold October night ....*" But, can things that only evoke fear in this life truly be scary for the Christian?

Jesus told us where real fear was found: "*And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell*" Matthew 10:28. This means that those gruesome things that the world chases after at this time of year don't really have power over us. First death (a separation of the soul from the body) is just a part of life and nothing to fear if we are in Christ—no matter how it may come about. Rather, it is the second death (a separation of the soul from God, who has all power) that a person should fear.

That's why songs that speak of the eternal separation of the sinner from the Lord are the scariest songs—and perhaps the third verse of "There's a Great Day Coming" is the most terrifying of all because it speaks of Judgment Day: "*There's a sad day coming, A sad day coming, There's a sad day coming by and by; When the sinner shall hear his doom, 'Depart, I know ye not,' Are you ready for that day to come?*"

Jesus' words coming from Matthew 7:21-23 speak of someone who externally checked all the boxes for what a Christian should do but didn't internally do the will of His Father. One who has obeyed the gospel and is living faithfully, though, has nothing to fear from this 'day' as "*the one who conquers will not be hurt by the second death*" Revelation 2:11.

For us that 'day' brings hope: "*There's a bright day coming, A bright day coming, There's a bright day coming by and by; But its brightness shall only come to them that love the Lord, Are you ready for that day to come?*"
