By faith, five Christians signed a note in 1923 to build a \$1,848.07 four-walled structure on a \$400 lot in Vienna to worship with twenty-five charter members, a figure that would be about \$46,000 today. They labored faithfully in the gospel to be His people, so that God in His great faithfulness would bless them through that next century.

That same year Thomas O. Chisholm wrote the hymn, “Great Is Thy Faithfulness,” based on what God’s people exclaimed when they entered captivity in Babylon because of their sins and realized the only thing they could trust in, *“It is of the LORD’s mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not; they are new every morning: **great is thy faithfulness**”* Lamentations 3:22-23 (KJV).

We have chronicled the amazing saga of the Lord’s servants and their service throughout the past century in a 100-page book that many who pre-ordered were able to pick-up this past week. In those seven sections, we outline the joys and challenges of the past ten decades and peer into our unknown future with hope because ... great is Thy faithfulness!

The refrain of that hymn is our theme as we anticipate the celebration of our Centennial next month and faithfully labor in the gospel for those coming after us in 36th Street’s next century:

Examples of items needed:

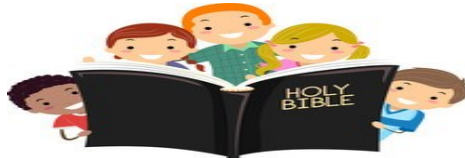
